Enclosed Shelter

The enclosed shelter is available for rent between the months of April - September at a cost of \$70 per day of use. The shelter includes a refrigerator, plus a totally enclosed facility with screened windows. Electrical outlets and a water source are available, as well as tables and chairs. Restrooms are nearby. Access to the enclosed shelter will be by key, which is available from City Hall during normal business hours. You must pay in full before you can use the enclosed shelter.



Original Open Shelter

The Original Open shelter is available for rent between the months of April - September at a cost of \$42 per day of use. The shelter includes a grill inside and outside. Electrical outlets and a water source are available, as well as tables and benches. Restrooms are located on the north side of the park. The shelter is available for use without paying only when it isn't reserved. There will not be power to the shelter unless you pay the \$42 fee. If you reserved the shelter and someone is there, please contact the police department at: (715) 823-3117



Lions Shelter

The Lions Shelter is available for rent between the months of April - September at a cost of \$42 per day of use. The shelter includes a grill inside and outside. Electrical outlets and a water source are available, as well as tables and benches. Restrooms are located right across the road. The shelter is available for use without paying only when it isn't reserved. There will not be power to the shelter unless you pay the \$42 fee. If you reserved the shelter and someone is there, please contact the police department at: (715) 823-3117

All shelter reservations can be made at City Hall, 50 10th Street, Clintonville, Wisconsin between the hours of 8:00 am - 4:30 pm. Payment is required at the time of rental to guarantee use. Reservations are taken at City Hall starting mid January for the current calendar year. Check out your local media for the official notice.
